

SIGN the register to say NO to a tax increase!

Mayor Leduc and his team want to impose a new special tax to build a regional infrastructure that is 100% paid by the taxpayers of Brossard.

As citizens, we can exercise our rights to oppose this recently adopted by-law. This by-law authorizes the city of Brossard to **borrow up to \$47 million** to build a regional overpass without any financial support from the provincial government. We should not give a blank check to Mayor Leduc for this project.

Such a loan would mean that an average house would **pay at least \$1,750 more in municipal taxes** and that is unacceptable !
